They will adjust to the needs of our post, and we could potentially ask them to add another time to speak specifically to Active Duty women, perhaps geared for all female service members throughout post (MP's and others) or even specifically CGSC students, which would be a great chapel outreach.

Neighborhood Bible Studies recruiting has started. Met three families Sunday who expressed enough interest in helping start/lead a study to give me their email and phone number. We will start having these families to our house for dinner this week. I plan to submit the weekend of 5-7 August to CH Grimes as the time for our Chapel Small Group/NBS recruiting and training event.

We met with a woman, Rachel Martinez (former Army and current spouse of a DA Civilian), Sunday who was very excited about being the first female member of our Christian Mentoring pool of Mentors. This is a true answer to years of prayer! They just moved here from Japan. She is an experienced Mentor and excited. I gave her the details for PWOC on Tuesday, and she is planning to attend. Christina is going to introduce her to Kay Hunter-Chester there. She is excited for that, and we (Christina and I) really think that will be a great connection for both.

The summer has been interesting in that we have not had nearly the amount of social media interaction with interested families as we have the past few summers. SM is how we make most of our initial linkups. Though they are down, we had a lot more people chat and sign up for ministry events after the 1100 service this past Sunday, the 9th. I will be down at Pioneer after the 0830 service and back in Frontier after the 1100 this Sunday, the 16th.
