- **1. Opening Prayer and Devotion** David Bodde shared a devotion from Isaiah 40:28 with the theme of "wait, walk, work" focused on the tension that comes from "waiting" and "walking." He shared Psalm 127 which reminds us that the Lord must build the house. If He doesn't, the builders labor in vain. He ended with some comments on prayer, for the purpose of discernment in the PAC.

- **3. Financial Updates.** CH McLean shared a quarterly expenses breakdown spreadsheet to show where Crossroads budget allocations have been committed.
- 4. Ministry Reports (Including updates on budget execution and planning)
- **DRE report:** Programs are up and running. We still need some Children's church leaders for both services. Youth club is being covered by volunteers and CH Herring and myself during contract down time. Sunday school is doing well.
- **-Lay Ministry:** Neighborhood Bible Studies (NBS) continue. Our Highly Exalted President and his lovely wife (Exalted President of PWOC) hosted our first Leaders session. It was awesome! Chris and Amy did an amazing job hosting. Chris led a devotional and there was time for sharing and prayer. It is definitely a sustain!

Discipleship Training Breakfast (DTB) averages about 30 each Tuesday.

Holy Smokes: GREAT this year. 7-10 men per meeting. This year we meet at Tom Schmidt's house when Kris Howell is travelling. The continuity clearly is positively impacting the trust and openness of the men.

Mentoring: We are a little behind normal numbers of individual mentoring relationships this year, but expect more to evolve from Holy Smokes, DTB, and NBS.

Coffee Conversations: Going well. 3-4 women meeting each week at Harbor Lights.

Music/Choir report: Plans are in place for the Christmas Cantata...I have it set for 15 December for several reasons. My understanding is that this works well with CGSC (they will not be on break yet) and also I will not have a full complement of choir members if we do it on the 8th. Other... everything sort of on hold with the musicians/AV and other contract situation ...

PWOC: -Established cleared volunteer roster for childcare during watch care contract gap. First week went well. We need six volunteers every week for the two volunteer rooms (in addition to the normal home school room), so we will be praying for sustainability of volunteers.
